DELIVERY OF THE LEARNING PROGRAM

- 1. Each module is delivered over 6 sessions in six weeks for a total of 42 cr hrs
- 2. Each 7 hour session per week comprises of 3.5 hours face to face class meeting and 3.5 hours online interactive learning/assessment time OL/AT).
- 3. A maximum of two courses/modules are prescribed for the six week registration period followed by an examination in the alternate week.



DELIVERY OF THE LEARNING PROGRAM

- 4. Upon completion of 4 courses/modules in 16 weeks, the grade point average (GPA) and Cumulative grade point average (CGPA) are computed and assigned accordingly to determine the student academic status.
- 5. Using a tri-semester assessment of student academic performance, graduate student would be able to complete the 12 courses/modules in one year.
- 6. The 6 credit hour project paper will be registered in week 32 to allow students to complete the guided project paper in 20 weeks.
